Alfreds Birth Place

Family history supplied to me for Alfred R. Munro is that he was born in Sylvania, MI. It is likely the reference is to Sylvan Twp., Washtenaw Co., MI, however his Army Documents indicate he was born in Albion, MI. (Albion, Calhoun Co., MI). In the 1840 census, about a year after his birth he was in Livonia, Wayne County, MI. Finding his birthplace will require a birth certificate, so this an ongoing project.

Rebellions of 1837

It was not to be a rebellion at all. The proposed march down Yonge Street in the colonial capital of Toronto was planned as an armed protest march, at least that was the story according to William Lyon Mackenzie, organizer of the protest. Unfortunately after a major confrontation he let a list of his followers fall into the hands of the government troops. In the Home District, 422 were arrested and charged with insurrection and treason, 61 of which had already fled Canada. Samuel, Jr, and Peter Munro were arrested and jailed on December 14, 1837. Peter was released December 23, 1837 and Samuel, Jr. on December 27, 1837. Records show both were "not tried -- discharged by Commission after examination". The Commission referred to here was created to review the charges. Because Peter and Samuel, Jr. were released, I am not sure if it was because they did not participate in the skirmish or because there was no proof.

It is assumed that all this provided the inspiration for Samuel to take his family and

leave Canada. A discrepancy in later records makes it difficult to pinpoint the exact date of this move.

A worthy pioneer, William Gifford, of North Madison (OH) most of the time for nearly eighty years passed away October 26, 1902 after an illness of five days with pneumonia.

Mr Gifford was born December 14, 1816. He was a son of Mr & Mrs Sylvanus Gifford of Brighton, Wayne County New York and oldest of his mother's seven children.

At the age of seven he moved from Brighton with his mother and stepfather Henry Pate to this place (Madison, Lake Co , OH) and located on the North Ridge (a road in Lake county) a little west of what was known to early settlers as Arcole. When seventeen years of age he took up the trade of iron moulding. His marked industry won for him a position at Arcole Furnace.

In 1836 William Gifford was married to Miss Sarah Cole of this place. They established their home a little west of where is now North Madison Town Hall. When the iron works were removed from Arcole to Buffalo NY Mr Gifford was for a time employed at that place. After which he returned here where he helped to clear the unbeaten track of the then scarcely settled neighborhood.

Here he shared the inconveniences of the pioneer life, so little known only to the few time honored citizens of whom Mr Gifford was the oldest pioneer here. The remainder of his active life he pursued the occupation of farming.

Since the year of 1893, his oldest son, George Gifford, moved from Pennsylvania and with his family has shared the home which his parents had occupied for more than fifty years and where the faithful wife and mother of twelve children died June 2, 1897.

Seven of their twelve children grew to maturity. Besides their son George there were four daughters present at the father's last sickness. Mesdames E.C Miller and A.R. Monroe of this place, Mesdames James Miller and J. T. Priaux of Maquokata, IA. One of the six surviving children, James Gifford of Delton, Wis(unreadable) ... attended at the family residence.

Rev. Barrett of Madison conducted the service. Music by C . Bates and Ma ry St. John of Madison and C. DeForest, Caty Haywood and Minnie Fost er of this place.

The floral decorations were abundant and exquisitely beautiful. The frie nds from out of town besides the daughters mentioned, from Iowa we re Mr M. V. B. Gifford of Erie PA, Mr & Mrs Daniel Merrel, Chardon (O H) , Mrs. Henry Crandall a nd Mrs C. Button of Geneva,"

Notes for Samuel Reid Munro, Sr.:

Our first record of Samuel Munro is when entered Canada at St. Johns in 1783. At that time he was recorded as "no corps" or not part of any military group. We estimate him to be about age 16 at that time.

His loyalty to the British is verified with the following quote from the " Ontario Crown Lands List of United Empire Loyalists in Canada". "Sam Sherwood Esquire dispoeth that Samuel Munro joined the Royal Standard before the Treaty of Separation in 1783".

This loyalty to the Crown made him a United Empire Loyalist; a group highly respected in Canada. It became a government policy to grant 200 acres of land to the Loyalists and to their sons and daughters when they became 21 years old or the daughter's married. This was called the Order In Council date, commonly seen as "OC" or "OIC". Great care was taken therefore to establish that only those qualified were entered on the U.E.L. list and received the Grants.

In Canada , Samuel Reid Munro settled in Yonge Township, Leeds County near the present site of Mallorytown, Ontario. Although there were several Munros who fought for the Kings Royal Regiment of New York and who settled in the same general area of Upper Canada. --- Above statement by Loren Munro, Munro Family Genealogist.

On November 18, 1815, Samuel Reid Munro, Sr., purchased 2 acres for L15.00 in Younge Twp., Ontario described as part of lot 14, concession 1, 2nd range bound by the King's road on the east. He sold it July 25, 1817, for L15.00. Samuel was listed on tax assessment records in 1802 but the property does not show up in the deed records. Next Samuel apparently moved to Richmond Hill, Ontario as I found him witnessing marriages of 2 of his daughters and for several other families in the

area. Richmond Hill is near Toronto, Canada. I found him again in Chinquancousy Township in Peel County, Ontario in 1828 when his son Samuel Reid Munro, J r. received a land grant from the Crown on October 17, 1828. Peel County is located just west of Toronto and contains the city of Brampton. Samuel eventually moved back to the Toronto area later as he was described as living in York Township in 1831 and 1834 when his son Peter M., and daughter Justina, received their land grants respectively.

At that time the city of Toronto was called York. The last information obtained of Samuel Reid Munro Sr., in Canada, he was still living in York or Toronto area when his sons Bradford and Malcolm received their land grants from the Crown in September 1826...Loren Munro

Loyalist (etc.) Nov. 23, 1836 signed Samuel Munro - Township of York in the Home District. Charles Munro was present and saw Samuel Munro sign the petition. Our last record of Samuel Munro, Sr. is the 1840 Federal Census -
Kalama Twp., Eaton Co., MI
Samuel Monro, 1 - Male 5 and under 10, 1 - Male 10 and under 15,
2 - Male 20 and under 30,
1 - Male 70 and under 80, 1 - Female 60 and under 70.

In 1840 Samuel, Jr. would be age 33, his first two sons would be William age 7 and James age 5.

The second male 20-29 may have been Johnson age 23 or
Walter Age 21 (both un-married)

Samuel, Sr., based on 1765 birth would be age 75 and Mary based on
1779 birth would be 61.

To further lead us to believe the older couple are Samuel, Sr. and Mary:

1- Mary was with Samuel Jr. in the 1850 and 1860, by that time Samuel, S r. likely had died.

2 -Catherine Dean Munro's Death Certificate (recently found) states that her fathers and mothers residence was Kalama, Eaton Co., MI.

As you are viewing these pages will see the names Munro, Munroe, Monro, Monroe and maybe a few others. They are all ancestors or descendants of Samuel Reid Munro. The spelling may have varied as a result of clerks and census enumerators writing down what they heard, while some individuals have elected to use another spelling. No matter the spelling those in this report are the Munro family.

He obtained possession December 30, 1828 and sold it on December 15, 1830.

On October 17, 1832, Samuel married Eliza (Elizabeth) Jane Mosher, probably in York County as her father, Daniel, lived in the North York area. Eliza was born on October 3, 1814 near Newport, Hants County, Nova Scotia. Her ancestors are documented in a book on the Mosher genealogy

In 1835 he purchased 200 acres west of Yonge, lot 25, concession 3 in York Township, York County. This farm was located at the corner of what is now Keele and Steeles Roads. He sold off the property in four parts starting March 4, 1835, with the last sale February 8, 1838. Walter A. Munro, his brother, was a witness to the first two sales and listed himself as "of" York and a laborer. The third sale on October 22, 1837 had Samuel's signature. The last sale was February 08, 1838 and was witnessed by David S. Dean, his brother-in-law.

Peter Munro (and his family?) were living with Samuel in 1836 and 1837 on his farm.

Rebellions of 1837

It was not to be a rebellion at all. The proposed march down Yonge Street in the colonial capital of Toronto was planned as an armed protest march, at least that was the story according to William Lyon Mackenzie, organizer of the protest. Unfortunately after a major confrontation he let a list of his followers fall into the hands of the government troops. In the Home District, 422 were arrested and charged with insurrection and treason, 61 of which had already fled Canada. Samuel, Jr, and his brother Peter Munro were arrested and jailed on December 14, 1837. Peter was released December 23, 1837 and Samuel, Jr. on December 27, 1837. Records show both were "not tried -- discharged by Commission after examination". The Commission referred to here was created to review the charges. Because Peter and Samuel, Jr. were released, I am not sure if it was because they did not participate in the skirmish or because there was no proof. It is assumed that all this provided the inspiration for Samuel to take his family and leave Canada. A discrepancy in later records makes it difficult to pinpoint the exact date of this move.

On April 14, 1848 Johnson bought 80 acres in section 11 of Sylvan Township for \$600.00. This farm was on Sibley Road near Chelsea adjoined the one owned at the time by his brother Samuel Reid Munro, Jr. At the same time, he bought 20 acres in section 9, of the same township.

He borrowed money on the land three times, \$400.00 on October 12, 1847 to purchase, \$105.00 on October 15, 1849 and \$400.00 again on January 09, 1852. Johnson lived on the Sibley Road farm for 16 years selling on March 17, 1864. Therefore, all his children were born at the Sibley Road farm.

Johnson moved his family to Rives Township, Jackson County, Michigan on April 20, 1864 when he purchased 80 acres in section 34 on what is now Henry Road. He sold it on October 23, 1865. He next bought 80 acres just down the road on the west on April 23, 1866. This farm was across the road from his brother Samuel Reid Munro, Jr., who had moved there about the same time. Johnson sold this farm on February 18, 1876.

On October 15, 1879 his son Sanford M. Munro, sold to Johnson a life lease on a lot in Blackman Township for \$1.00. It was located just north of Jackson in the northwest quarter of Section 27 on what is now Lansing Avenue. At that time, Johnson had given up farming and was a laborer.

Johnson and his wife were back in Washtenaw County in 1889.

The date doesn't fit in with what little I know about the CA gold rush, but it could have been Colorado or who knows where. And again, it was William's story via Mary Ellen, so that's that.

Well who knows how long it took Desire to decide it was OK to remarry or how all that came about, but she did remarry to Henry Pate and they went to Madison, Lake County Ohio forthwith, perhaps leaving lots of difficult memories behind? I'd love to know more about where she came from & if her Burdick family can be located. So many questions & so little time.

Grandmother also told us that since her dad (George Gifford) took the family to live with her grandfather (William) when he got older, she got to talk a lot with old William and he was fond of reminiscing. He supposedly told her that he used to be teased a lot by children because his name was Gifford and his "father's" name was Pate and some of the children were not allowed to play with him because his

mother had remarried or some such thing.

It's all very interesting to speculate about but I'd love to have more concrete information. If any of you have more information or can help me speculate I'd love to know it!

"I the subscriber, do hereby certify that [in] the fall [of] 1782 - was sent by General Haldiman[d], then Commissioner and Chief of the Province of Quebec etc.etc, etc. [how they shortened one's numerous titles], as a Flag etc to take a number of prisoners, men, women etc, to East Bay at the south end of Lake Champlain in the state of New York, and when he arrived there, found there families waiting for an

opportunity to get to Saint Johns in the Lower Province, and, after landing the prisoners, sent their boats back to Crown Point to the shipping [docks] and the families waiting[:] viz Mrs. Spooner and children, John Atkin's wife and children, and Mrs. Catherine Leech and children; and do certify that Mrs. Catherine Proctor is daughter of the said Mrs. Leech.

Given under my hand in Yonge, the 17 January 1808. Thos. Smyth, J.P."
"For this same petition, another individual, Peter Howard J.P., also certified that the Munro family came to Quebec in 1782 and then came to Ontario in 1785."

Catherine Leech sent a petition from Augusta township in August, 1789:
"That your Petitioner had Considerable property taken from her in the Colonies, & her husband was Murdered By the rebels, on account of his attachment to the British Government. That your petitioner is Desirous of becoming an Inhabitant in this District. She therefore prays the Hone Board will be pleased to Grant her two Hundred acres of Land, as a Compensation for her Losses and Sufferings ."
As a result, she was "admitted for two hundred acres" (endnote 14). There is no discernible evidence that Mrs Leech was asked to provide proof of her husband's allegiance or service to the Crown.

All William Gifford genealogy concerning his father Phillip and his ancestors is totally unverified and should not be used for serious genealogy purposes.

Arrived in New England after 1643. William was a Quaker and his 3rd wife, Mary, was a "vagabond" "traveling" Quaker missionary. Per Little Compton Families which cites the Tall man family records by William M. Emery, "William Gifford, a member of the Society of Friends, is found at Sandwich in 1650. Although he suffered the persecutions visited upon the Quakers of that time, he prospered in material affairs and became a large land owner. It is supposed that he was the William Gifford who in 1647 or earlier was ordered by the court at Stamford to be whipped and banished. He lived at Sandwich until his death December 21, 1687 except for the years 1665 - 1670, when he and others became proprietors of Monmouth Co., N J, by purchase of land from the Indians. In a deed by his son Christopher, he was described as a tailor. On 10 Nov Mr. Gifford bought of mistress, Sarah Warren of Plymouth, widow of Richard Warren, one half her share in the land at Dartmouth, which by deed 6 May 1683 he gave equally to his sons Christopher and Robert. He also owned land in Sandwich, Falmouth, and Rhode Island. On the grounds that William had been a tailor, the records of the tailors (tailors) Guild of London were explored. Three Williams were listed, only one of whom fits in to the appropriate dates. Under apprenticeship of 7 years, they could not marry until free. This William married Elizabeth Grant in 1635. William H. Gifford was apprenticed to Thomas Southern, 7 Dec. 1628. (The other listed William's were apprenticed in 1564 & 1650). Elizabeth and William did not come to America until after 1643. There were 7 other Giffords apprenticed between 1573 and 1682, three of whom were apprenticed to other Giffords.

"By the sword and the cross," Charlemagne (Charles the Great) became master of Western Europe. It was falling into decay when Charlemagne became joint king of the Franks in 768. Except in the monasteries, people had all but forgotten education and the arts. Boldly Charlemagne conquered barbarians and kings alike. By restoring the roots of learning and order, he preserved many political rights and revived culture.

Charlemagne's grandfather was Charles Martel, the warrior who crushed the Saracens (see Charles Martel). Charlemagne was the elder son of Bertrada ("Bertha Greatfoot") and Pepin the Short, first "mayor of the palace" to become king of the Franks. Although schools had almost disappeared in the 8th century, historians believe that Bertrada gave young Charles some education and that he learned to read. His devotion to the church became the great driving force of his remarkable life.

Charlemagne was tall, powerful, and tireless. His secretary, Eginhard, wrote that Charlemagne had fair hair and a "face laughing and merry . . . his appearance was always stately and dignified." He had a ready wit, but could be stern. His tastes were simple and moderate. He delighted in hunting, riding, and swimming. He wore the Frankish dress: linen shirt and breeches, a silk-fringed tunic, hose wrapped with bands, and, in winter, a tight coat of otter or marten skin. Over all these garments "he flung a blue cloak, and he always had a sword girt about him."

Charlemagne's character was contradictory. In an age when the usual penalty for defeat was death, Charlemagne several times spared the lives of his defeated foes; yet in 782 at Verdun, after a Saxon uprising, he ordered 4,500 Saxons beheaded. He compelled the clergy and nobles to reform, but he divorced two of his four wives without any cause. He forced kings and princes to kneel at his feet, yet his mother and his two favorite wives often overruled him in his own household.

Charlemagne Begins His Reign

In 768, when Charlemagne was 26, he and his brother Carloman inherited the kingdom of the Franks.

In 771 Carloman died, and Charlemagne became sole ruler of the kingdom. At that time the northern

half of Europe was still pagan and lawless. In the south, the Roman Catholic church was striving to assert its power against the Lombard kingdom in Italy. In Charlemagne's own realm, the Franks were falling back in to barbarian ways, neglecting their education and religion.

Charlemagne was determined to strengthen his realm and to bring order to Europe. In 772 he launched a 30-year campaign that conquered and Christianized the powerful pagan Saxons in the north. He subdued the Avars, a huge Tartar tribe on the Danube. He compelled the rebellious Bavarian dukes to submit to him. When possible he preferred to settle matters peacefully, however. For example, Charlemagne offered to pay the Lombard king Desiderius for return of lands to the pope, but, when Desiderius refused, Charlemagne seized his kingdom in 773 to 774 and restored the Papal States.

The key to Charlemagne's amazing conquests was his ability to organize. During his reign he sent out more than 50 military expeditions. He rode as commander at the head of at least half of them. He moved his armies over wide reaches of country with unbelievable speed, but every move was planned in advance. Before a campaign he told the counts, princes, and bishops throughout his realm how many men they should bring, what arms they were to carry, and even what to load in the supply wagons. These feats of organization and the swift marches later led Napoleon to study his tactics.

One of Charlemagne's minor campaigns has become the most famous. In 778 he led his army into Spain to battle the infidel Saracens. On its return, Basques ambushed the rear guard at Roncesvalles, in northern Spain, and killed "Count Roland." Roland became a great hero of medieval songs and romances.

By 800 Charlemagne was the undisputed ruler of Western Europe. His vast realm covered what are now France, Switzerland, Belgium, and The Netherlands. It included half of present-day Italy and Germany, part of Austria, and the Spanish March ("border"). The broad March reached to the Ebro River. By thus establishing a central government over Western Europe, Charlemagne restored much of the unity of the old Roman Empire and paved the way for the development of modern Europe.

Crowned Emperor

On Christmas Day in 800, while Charlemagne knelt in prayer in Saint Peter's in Rome, Pope Leo III seized a golden crown from the altar and placed it on the bowed head of the king. The throng in the church shouted, "To Charles the August, crowned by God, great and pacific emperor, long life and victory!"

Charlemagne is said to have been surprised by the coronation, declaring that he would not have come into the church had he known the pope's plan. However, some historians say the pope would not have dared to act without Charlemagne's knowledge.

The coronation was the foundation of the Holy Roman Empire. Though Charlemagne did not use the title, he is considered the first Holy Roman emperor (see Holy Roman Empire).

Reform and Renaissance

Charlemagne had deep sympathy for the peasants and believed that government should be for the benefit of the governed. When he came to the throne, various local governors, called "counts," had become lax and oppressive. To reform them, he expanded the work of investigators, called missidominici. He prescribed their duties in documents called capitularies and sent them out in teams of two a churchman and a noble. They rode to all parts of the realm, inspecting government, administering justice, and reawakening all citizens to their civil and religious duties. Twice a year Charlemagne summoned the chief men of the empire to discuss its affairs. In all problems he was the final arbiter, even in church issues, and he largely unified church and state.

Charlemagne was a tireless reformer who tried to improve his people's lot in many ways. He set up money standards to encourage commerce, tried to build a Rhine-Danube canal, and urged better farming methods. He especially worked to spread education and Christianity in every class of people.

He revived the Palace School at Aachen, his capital. He set up other schools, opening them to peasant boys as well as nobles.

Charlemagne never stopped studying. He brought an English monk, Alcuin, and other scholars to his court. He learned to read Latin and some Greek but apparently did not master writing. At meals, instead of having jesters perform, he listened to men reading from learned works.

To revive church music, Charlemagne had monks sent from Rome to train his Frankish singers. To restore some appreciation of art, he brought valuable pieces from Italy. An impressive monument to his religious devotion is the cathedral at Aachen, which he built and where he was buried (see Aachen).

At Charlemagne's death in 814 only one of his three sons, Louis, was living. Louis's weak rule brought on the rise of civil wars and revolts. After his death his three quarreling sons split the empire between them by the Partition of Verdun in 843.

Charlemagne, his predecessors and the people who flourished during his reign left a mark on European civilization that could long be seen in everyday society.

It was Charlemagne who devised the system of pounds, shillings and pence used throughout Europe in the middle ages and in Britain until the 1970s.

The title of Margrave (Marquis or Marquess) dates to Charlemagne's reign, when the emperor appointed trusted noblemen of military background to oversee newly acquired territories, frontier lands known as marches. The word Graf, "leader," was combined with march, and the word Margraf or Margrave was born. The titles Duke (from the Latin dukis) and Count (comte, from the Old French for companion) also date to the era of the Carolingians.

The Carolingian Handwriting that evolved during Charlemagne's reign was developed to increase the legibility of the numerous manuscripts the monks turned out at this time. These small letters, known as Carolingian minuscule, became the basis of the lower-case letters we use today.

90% of the works of ancient Rome now in existence are preserved in the form of eighth- and ninth-century manuscripts copied in a Carolingian monastery.
